b. Deputy Prime Minister.....Dante Pio

- I. Campus Card Committee Report
 - Attended the committee meeting.
 - Talked about partnership with Skip the Dishes.
 - Cost of lost student cards has increased to \$30.
 - Possibility of having mobile credentials, which may start in 2027.
 Will reduce the amount of plastic that has to be used. You would have your student card on your phone. Still exploring the possibility. Did this with the transit card a few years ago.
- II. Athletics Committee Report
 - Attended the committee meeting.
 - Updates on the pool: Adding an accessibility ramp and head blocks for competitive swimmers. There will be a phased opening.
 - Gym has seen new equipment: Stairmaster, leg press, etc.

- Goal to include more fitness classes next semester to match precovid levels.
- The place where 76 Sips used to be, they're planning on it not becoming a food place.

III. CASSC Report

- Dante will post a budget training sheet to Microsoft Teams.
- For people who have their exams in the gym, bags may now be stored in the locker rooms instead of at the front of the gym.
- Champlain currently has an acting principle while they look for a new principle.
- Canada has launched a 988 line to help provide 24/7 mental health support.
- Discussed looking at how to include Indigeneity within all of the colleges.

- II. Food Services Committee Report Rushk
 - Discussed how the TCSA will be giving out \$5 off meal cards to help battle food insecurity, could fund 1000 people a week. Sarah adds that you can't use them at chain restaurants, and that they are looking at expanding it to Durham.
 - Might be doing a waste competition to promote recycling.
 - They want to keep the price of the meal plan the same as this year, however this would mean there would be less purchasing power

for the meal plan. Students voted for the meal plan to increase to avoid this issue.

 - Eden purchased an office chair, and other furniture. They have arrived at her house.

e. TCSA Commissioner.....Sarah Ovens

- I. TCSA Meeting December 3
 - Discussed some of the events they ran throughout the past months.
 - Did a seminar on safety and gave out various safety gear.
 - Discussed student concerns on students accessing resources and how they have to go back and forth on resources. Want to try to help students pinpoint where they need to go.
 - Looking at running a survey on the One Stop Chop pantry.
 - Looking at reaching out to OPIRG to educate others on social justice issues.
 - \$5 punch a lunch discount card.
 - Discussed the destress week events and giving out exam care packages.
 - Next housing advisory committee meeting is in January.
 - Planning Frost Week (a condensed version of orientation week for people starting in the winter semester).
 - Some clubs went against their own constitutions, people are trying to decide the consequences to these actions.
 - Advocating for exam rescheduling.
 - The frictionless market for Bata Bean has been offline for the past little bit.
 - At Champlain they are thinking of making a value menu.
 - Thinking of potentially expanding the hours for each of the dining halls during the exam season.
 - Changes in some of the election rules and regulations when running for a TCSA position. Changed the word Chief to Lead. Reminding people the rules for campaign promotions.

- I. CASSC Wellness Committee
 - Went to the committee meeting.
 - Covers student accessibility services, health services, etc.
 - Onboarded two new staff members for student accessibility services.
 - Trying a new process with a small group of students and see how it works.
 - Strategies for supporting students without doctors, which has limited people getting doctor's notes to access SAS.
 - Discussed faculty members not supporting SAS.

- Discussed fear of bringing issues to SAS staff, might think of creating a committee that links faculty and students.
- More doctors were hired for health services.
- Online booking for STI testing and birth control appointments.
- Trent has now gone to a single session counseling services method.
- Implementing a lot more group events.
- Trying to hire a crisis counselor to work within residence. Looking to create a support group for Dons until then.
- 1800 students are expected to write their exams in the CAT.
 Adding more space is currently not being seen as a priority.
- Budget was discussed.
- Next meeting will be in January or February.
