Those interested in the P/J stream, we strongly encourage students to take a breadth of courses, potentially in their first year, to gain better content knowledge in course subjects (i.e. English, Geography, History, Sciences).

Other programs at the Intermediate/Senior level do not provide sufficient credit room to work with the TES requirements, plus the requirements for two Teaching Subjects that are available in the B.Ed. program. Some additional programs may be possible with credit overloading and/or taking additional summer credits.
