- Completion of secondary school certificate or diploma
- Minimum academic admission average of 70% (Canadian equivalency)

FINANCING YOUR EDUCATION IN CANADA

Studying at Trent University in Canada is a valuable investment. We offer various financial support options to help reduce education costs, including scholarships, jobs, co-op programs, and internships.

Automatic Entrance Scholarships: Students with an average of 80% or higher receive \$1,000 to \$3,000 automatically, without needing to apply.
